NPA/BRHS GUIDELINES

The current agreement between Northpoint Academy and Bear River High School allows students to dual enroll in graduation track classes that are not available at BRHS. To qualify for this privilege, all of the following criteria must be met.

Student must be in good standing with current school of record (i.e. no significant
behavior, attendance or grade/credit issues).
Student must currently have and maintain a minimum of a 2.5 GPA overall.
Student must be a self-motivated learner able to stay current with the scaffolded
assignments in Apex (determined by interviewing current teachers and reviewing
IPRs/Synergy/Schoology).
Student may not be more than 10 credits deficient.
Requested course/s must be necessary for graduation and cannot be offered or be
available as an option for student at current school site.
Senior English and Government/Economics are NOT available through NPA due to senio
project criteria.
As per Ed Code, student must be enrolled in a 5/1 or 4/2 split for dual enrollment.
Dual enrollment may not be used for the purpose of changing teachers.
Students who do not successfully pass the enrolled class during the current semester
will not be able to dual enroll at NPA again. The student will return to Bear River or
transfer to the most appropriate setting.
No partial credits will be awarded
