# BEAR RIVER HIGH SCHOOL Athletic Hall of Fame

# Overview, Criteria & Selection Process

Originated 2010

## **Purpose**

In order to preserve the heritage and tradition of athletic excellence at Bear River High School, the Bear River Athletic Hall of Fame was created in 2010 to honor the very best in the history of Bruin athletics.

This special honor will recognize members of the Bear River family who distinguished themselves as outstanding contributors to athletics at Bear River High School, and possibly beyond, by demonstrating an ongoing commitment to, and the promotion of, athletic excellence, character values, and good sportsmanship.

## Criteria

Bear River Athletic Hall of Fame nominees will be considered primarily on their achievements as high school student-athletes. Limited consideration will be given to their achievements on the college or professional levels. *Character values, during and after their high school years, however, will be a major consideration.* 

#### **Student-Athletes:**

- Nominee must be a graduate of Bear River High School.
- The candidate shall be eligible to be nominated no earlier than seven (7) years after his or her graduation.
- The candidate must have been a varsity team member of the sport for which he or she is being nominated.
- The candidate must have made a positive impact on the team(s) for which he or she played, including measurable athletic achievement (see suggested benchmarks below).
- The candidate must have conducted himself/herself in such a way as to reflect honor to the school and must have exhibited those qualities of character and standards of conduct during and after high school, consistent with their status as a role model to the community. Bear River High School reserves the right to remove any individual from the Hall of Fame for personal conduct which reflects discredit upon the school.

Nominees may be considered posthumously

### **Suggested Benchmarks for Consideration**

- 1- Most Valuable Player of the League/ All League
- 2- All Metro (Sacramento Bee) Honors
- 3- Individual Sac-Joaquin Section, State Champion
- 4- Cal Hi, or Max Prep All State recognition
- 5- All American Status
- 6- Holder of School, League, State, National record(s)
- 7- Athlete of the Year
- 8- Significant contributor to Championship team(s)
- 9- Scholarship Recipient
- 10- Outstanding honors in college or professional sport

The greater the number of benchmarks possessed by a candidate, or the more substantial an individual benchmark (i.e. National record holder, State Player of the Year), the greater his or her chance of being inducted into the Hall of Fame. While many student-athletes have had outstanding athletic careers at Bear River High School, only a few will have amassed the number of significant benchmarks appropriate for Hall of Fame recognition.

## Selection Committee

The Selection Committee will be comprised of the following individuals:

- Bear River High School Principal
- Bear River High School Athletic Director
- •2-4 Community Members appointed by the Athletic Director and Principal

#### Selection Process

Names for nominations may be submitted by anyone for committee review.

Nominations are due no later than September 1, each year.

To be approved for induction, the candidate must receive a majority of the votes from the Selection Committee.

Nominees not selected for induction into the Hall of Fame are ineligible for nomination the following year. However, after this one-year period of ineligibility, a candidate may again be nominated and considered.

All nominations must include full name of nominee (while they attended or were affiliated with Bear River High School), year of graduation, particular sports, achievements, and the complete contact information of the nominator. Only nominations that include this information and are received on or before September 1, will be considered for that year's class of inductees.

#### *Induction Process*

- A. Awards each inductee will receive a plaque bearing his/her likeness as well as a written dialogue documenting his/her accomplishments. A duplicate plaque will be added to the Hall of Fame wall display in the McCrory gymnasium.
- B. A ceremony to honor the inductees will be determined by the Selection Committee. The date and activity of the ceremony will be appropriate for the class being inducted. Examples of appropriate ceremonial events would be the fall and winter homecoming games.

# General Instructions for completing Nomination Form

All information on this form must be completed and supporting materials received on or before September 1, to be considered for that school year. Please attempt to attach newspaper clippings, certificates, statistics, letters of recommendation, etc. to substantiate the candidate's accomplishments. Only copies of the original items should be submitted as Bear River High School is not responsible for the return of these items.

If the nominee is inducted into the Hall of Fame, the nominee or individual submitting the nomination shall furnish an 8"x10" color photograph of the nominee.
