 - □ What sets you apart as an applicant? Why should people vote for you?

General Information

- You must have a minimum **3.0 GPA and no Fs** to run for office
- You must have a fair understanding of the position for which you are applying and the ASB Constitution
- Job Descriptions: This document carefully lays out the expectations for each position. Read over this thoroughly.
- <u>ASB Constitution</u>: This is another resource to read over before applying, job positions are also listed here.
- <u>Candidate Eligibility</u> will be established before interviews and elections begin and continue through the interview process.
- All applicants are to be interviewed by current Council members. If you have limitations regarding internet access or device availability, please contact the ASB Vice President at <u>23desautol@student.njuhsd.com</u>
- You will be asked a series of questions by the current Executive Council including, but not limited to...
 - Your specific plans for your position
 - Your qualifications to hold the position
 - You will be contacted by the ASB Vice President with an interview time
 - It is a good idea to wear professional attire for your interview
- All members of Executive Council will be enrolled in the Leadership class for the school year
 - This will dictate some schedule options
 - See the Activities Director for information
- All applicants are required to complete the <u>Written Interview</u> questions by the application due date
 - Written interviews should be submitted here
 - All members of Executive Council are required to attend Executive Council and Student Congress meetings
- Executive Council is a considerable time commitment
 - Plan on devoting time after school and on weekends

- Make sure you are applying for the right reasons
- Executive Council is a great way to truly make a difference on campus
- Executive Council meetings are held once a week during Flex time
- Student Congress meets at least once per month during the school day

- All members of the Executive Council must attend the one day summer retreat on August 1, 2023
- All first week of school activities: spirit days, rally run throughs, rally, dance set up and clean up
- **Homecoming week for fall 2023 is 10/2-10/6**. Participation in spirit weeks, decorations, rallies, halftime shows, and dances is expected

Appointed Officer Information

- Appointed Officers are installed based solely on the interview process
 - Interviews will be held for Appointed Officers after the results of the general election have been released
- Applicants who ran for an elected office unsuccessfully may also run for an appointed office
- You should **not** make/post campaign materials for an Appointed Office

Officer Code of Ethics

- All members of Executive Council shall adhere to the <u>Code of Ethics</u>
- Violation of the code will result in immediate removal from office by the Activities Director
- The Activities Director reserves the right to define behavior unbecoming of a Member of Executive Council, and may interpret and apply the code as they deem necessary

- By submitting the Executive Council Application Form, you are acknowledging that...
 - Any violation of the rules in this document may require disciplinary measures and will result in disqualification
 - A record of good scholarship must be maintained in order to hold a position on Executive Council
 - Members of Executive Council will be enrolled in Leadership class for the school year
 - Failure to fulfill the duties and requirements outlined in the ASB Constitution will result in removal from office and the class
 - Executive Council is a considerable time commitment and may require **devotion of time after school** and on weekends

 - Understand the duties/requirements of the Executive Council Position for which their child is applying
 - Be prepared to give their child the necessary support to fulfill the obligations of Executive Council
