General Information

- You must have a minimum **2.5 GPA and no Fs** to be in Leadership class
- You must have a fair understanding of the commitment for which you are signing up for

- **Required Dates**
 - Frosh Orientation: **TBD (week before school starts)**
 - All members of the Leadership class must attend the one day summer retreat on August 1, 2023
 - All first week of school activities: spirit days, rally run throughs, rally, dance set up and clean up
 - **Homecoming week for fall 2023 is 9/30-10/6**. Participation in spirit weeks, decorations, rallies, halftime shows, and dances is expected

 - Failure to fulfill the requirements outlined in the ASB Constitution/Code of Ethics/Application packet will result in removal from the class
 - Leadership is a considerable time commitment and may require **devotion of time after school and on weekends**
