- Drive carelessly or recklessly
- Use inappropriate language
- Associate myself with individuals or activities that reflect poorly on me, the program or the school
- Be rude in any situation
- Judge others
- Gossip or bully
- Make mean or hurtful comments

I pledge to demonstrate responsibility. I am conscientious and dependable.

I will...

- Recognize that I am a role model at all times
- Meet all deadlines
- Motivate others to my full ability
- Execute my work as well as I possibly can
- Know my limits and be aware of them at all
- Continue to keep trying and working towards the set goal
- Seek help when needed
- Give chances to those who want to contribute
- Organize projects to support my school
- Participate in long-term service

I will not...

- Arrive to meetings late
- Turn in assignments after the deadline
- Back down or give up when an assignment becomes difficult
- Take on more than I and my limits can handle
- Settle for the bare minimum doing the least amount of work possible

I pledge to act with integrity. I live in a way that is consistent with my values, so others can trust me.

I will...

- Be honest about who I am and what I believe in so others may see who I truly am
- Complete my own work
- Refuse to cheat
- Say "No" to any peer that pressures me to do something I do not believe, such as drinking and drugs
