

The Nevada Joint Union High School District is located in northern California about sixty miles northeast of Sacramento. Nevada County has eight elementary/middle school districts feeding into the high schools, which provide secondary education to 3,000 students with a variety of schools and programs. NJUSD offers placement at 4 comprehensive high schools (including independent study) and two non-traditional

schools.



Bear River is a small, comprehensive 4-year public high school. Built in 1986, it was designed to serve the residents of southern Nevada County in its rural setting.

Bear River High School was recognized as a California Distinguished School in 2001 and 2009, and a Gold Ribbon School in 2017. During the last five years, the school has become a model program for Professional Learning Communities implementing teacher collaboration, pyramids of intervention, and common assessments.
