

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

High School! Exciting, nerve wracking, challenging, enlightening, the list goes on. Our graduation requirements reflect what employers and colleges are looking for. Students need a total of 220 credits to graduate and credits are earned by successfully passing each class. Each class is worth 5 credits per semester. Required classes that are not passed must be retaken through afterschool or summer credit recovery program.

BRHS Graduation Requirements:

English	4 years: English 9, 10, 11 & 12
Math	3 years: Must include 1 year of Algebra I or Integrated Mathematics I
Social Studies	3 years: World History, US History, Government/ Economics
Science	2 years: 1 year each of a Life & Physical Science
Physical Ed	2 years: 1 year Freshman PE & 1 year of PE or 2 seasons of a sport (grade 10-12)
Foreign Language OR Visual/Performing Art	1 year: Of a V/P art class OR a foreign language
Frosh Tech/Health	1 year: 1 semester of each

Four Year Plan:

Starting in freshman year, we meet with students to discuss their long term goals. This includes our 4 year plan that aids students in making sure they clearly understand the differences between graduation requirements and college admission requirements.

Things To Remember:

- * You need 1 additional year of P.E. or 2 seasons of a sport between 10 - 12 grades. Sports in freshman year do not count toward this credit.
- * Just taking a class does not get you credit. You must pass the class to obtain that necessary credit.
- * A foreign language **is not required** for graduation but is required for acceptance into a 4 year college
- * Honors and Advanced Classes are recommended for the UC System.
- * Fourth year of math is very important for college bound students.
